- Schaefer's Final Site Plan Approval with Conditions

In depth discussion regarding URS's concerns in their four page letter dated June 10, 2011. Phase 1 is everything except the banquet hall.

The owner has requested that if he replaces the sewer line across the street, making it whole and doing everything that the town requests, (he has purchased the properties), that he be mitigated 36 parking spaces. Parking spaces are not proposed in Phase I. That decision is up to the Mayor and Council. At this time there is no parking available for Phase II. The owner is trying to make arrangements for the Sister's property.

Question about the veranda on the east side may be problems with adjoining property. Ortt's requesting that the table(s) on the east side be taken out. Owner will program the generator to cycle at a time that's convenient to neighbors as not to disturb them in the evenings, unless it's an emergency, i.e. power outage.

Per the Town Engineer the Town needs to write a letter verifying water and sewer capacity based on seating. Still need the water treatment plant statement from Artesian. The Town will need to write a formal letter to the Health Department verifying that the capacity is still there based on seating; and the Health Department is also requesting that the letter state regarding a time limit on whether or not the capacity is available if not used. Town Administrator is aware of the letter.

MOTION: Frank Vari made a motion, Elaine Shepard seconded to approve Schaefer's final site plan subject to the conditions listed in the letter dated June 10, 2011 from URS; and that the water capacity be confirmed by Artesian and a letter sent to the Health Department. All in favor, motion carried.
