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General Activities 8/1-8/31/2011:

410 Cecil Street – satellite dish placement issue, next door neighbor complaining. On-going issue, building permit started, still awaiting sketches for placement options. Met with occupant of property, reviewed ordinance, also met with complainant. Continuing to follow up.

Re-inspected several properties already cited for violations to confirm compliance. Performed full driving inspection of North and South sides, 5xs. Made several spot inspections of specific properties throughout the month.

Handled 3 tree removal permits – 300-302 Third Street; 222 Charles Street; 511 Biddle Street

Taproom – Meeting with owner and Mayor to once again hear grievances. Issue has been resolved; Town ruling stands.

424 George Street - did interior inspection and took photos for County in preparation for permit issuance. Permit has been issued by County. Reminded contractor needed to obtain Ches. City green card as well when noticed work being continued without green card.

501 Cecil Street – even though in foreclosure, property was mowed once.

324 Hemphill – ongoing issue with regard to window replacement and siding replacement. Permit not obtained prior to work starting, windows do not comply with current architectural standards. Multiple phone calls and meetings with property owner and contractor to try and resolve issue.

626 Biddle – phone conversations with contractor to answer questions on materials.

Chesapeake Inn sign permit request – reviewed information and found it compliant with current ordinances.

Violation letters to: Peach (boat – taking fuel delivery at transient dockage); 103 Bohemia Avenue (overgrown trees/shrubs in street & alley); 10 Boat Yard Row (overgrown trees/shrubs in street); 219 Bank Street (overgrown weeds/grass); 214 Biddle Street (overgrown weeds/grass); 201 Lock Street (basketball net in street); 415 Biddle Street (satellite dish placement in front of building)

Research/follow up on Schaefer's project regarding necessity for joint permit with MDE.

Letter to 608 Biddle explaining yard waste pickup requirements.


Check on 232 Biddle to make sure unit is unoccupied – concern about water usage. Probably due to watering of new grass and installation of tile flooring inside.

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Investigated several complaints from citizens regarding various addresses that did not turn out to be issues.

Began foot patrols and citation writing after training by Sheriff Department personnel. Typically work several hours per week, usually on weekends during hours when Sheriff's Department personnel are not in Town.
