March 19, 2018

Unfinished Business:

Town Manager Rob Bernstine gave an update on projects and infrastructure. Discussion of Public Works and what John and Jesse are currently working on.

New Business:

Historic Vacancy: There are currently two people interested in the open spot. The Mayor will speak to both of them and get back to Council

Noise Ordinance: Moving to April Workshop, Council to review Commissioner Blevin's handout from the last meeting.

Generator – Carolyn is working with John Loveless, there's only one quote at this time. It's \$9000 installed and hooked up to propane. Mayor Taylor would like to stay in the \$7500 range. Move to the April Workshop.

Resolution Public Safety – Formally adopt at the next meeting.

Open Council Seats – have had two people Frank Hill and Lee Collins to fill the seats until the end of their term. There will be a Special Session on Saturday to swear them in.

Public Comment –

April 1st Easter – Sunrise Service at Pell Gardens.

Easter Egg Hunt will probably not be this Saturday after the snow and rain. Planning to move it to the open spot at St Rose Catholic Church beside the Fire Company. If it rains, will be inside the Fire House.

Elections-June 4, 2018. Candidates are able to apply until May 4, 2018. Papers are available in Town Hall, will be in the paper the beginning of April.

Charter Amendments: The Amendments is null and void because there were not published. Will vote again at the April meeting.

Closed Session on Saturday for Code Enforcement and compensation.

Mayor – thanking for everyone the Parade ; attended SHA meeting regarding truck traffic on 213 with Commissioner Vari. A traffic study to be done to determine the amount of traffic for the tolls. We should be expecting more traffic from trucks traveling to avoiding tolls and weigh stations.
