Public Announcements:

Frank Hill: Elections were held last Monday. Dean Geracimos was elected Mayor; Two Council members seats were open, Harry Sampson and Elaine Shepard were elected into office and Ron Francis with complete Dean's term for Council. A Quorum was not expected for this meeting, so action items were moved to Wednesday evening's Special Session. Canal Fest will be on the 30th – on a smaller scale. We received the top small Town recycling award for the State of MD. We will be receiving another from the county. Would like to thank Mr. Vari for all his help.
